2. Discussion of Native Plantings

Continued discussion ensued as to the native plantings ordinance, the scope of plantings and the overall intention of the ordinance. Discussion centered on overall height and density. The goal is to provide for health, safety, and welfare of the residents. Attention was paid to visibility, especially in terms of being able to see the address of the property from the street. Density and overall lot coverage were also discussed.
